


Sundays @ the J with George and friends

Bill Christophersen was born in the Bronx and received a doctorate in American literature from Columbia University. He is the author of *The Apparition in the Glass: Charles Brockden Brown's American Gothic* (U. of Georgia Press) and *Resurrecting Leather-Stocking: Pathfinding in Jacksonian America* (U. of S. Carolina Press, as well as three poetry collections—*Two Men Fighting in a Landscape* (Aldrich Press), The Dicer's Cup (Kelsay Books) and *Tableau with Crash Helmet* (Hanging Loose Press). His book reviews and critical essays have appeared in *Newsweek, The New Leader, The New York Times Book Review, The American Book Review* and *Poetry*. His poems have won awards from *Rhino,* the *Kansas Quarterly* and the Robinson Jeffers Tor House Foundation, and have been nominated for a Pushcart Prize and for inclusion in *Best New Poets 2014*. He lives in New York and plays traditional and bluegrass fiddle.



Jim Garber finds his poetic voice in the rhythms and tones of everyday speech interspersed with quotidian absurdities. His poem "Apology" won runner-up in the 2017 Elizabeth R. Curry Poetry Contest and was published in *SLAB Literary Magazine*. He also served as editor of *Bring Me a Lamp: An Anthology of Poems by Modern Iranian Poets*. He reads regularly at poetry events in and around the greater New York City area. His other passions include playing traditional music on fiddle, mandolin and guitar.
