

Dubbs is the founder and executive producer of *Thank You for Coming Out*, a queer improv show, and co-founder and executive producer of *Craft Your Truth*, an organization that encourages LGBTQ folks to use any kind of performance art as a way to express their stories and connect with their community around them. Dubbs earned their B.S. from The Ohio State University and currently volunteers with *New Alternatives*. They are currently writing a book.

Border Report: Children in Need (with the Westchester Jewish Coalition for Immigration *Sunday, June 6 at 7:30 pm*, [Westchester Jewish Coalition for Immigration](https://www.wjci.org/) (WJCI) will host a countywide zoom event to educate our community about how to advocate and provide critical support to immigrant children impacted by the situation at the southern border. WJCI is aware that children arriving at the southern border without their parents have presented a political and humanitarian challenge. These numbers began rising considerably after 2009 when 19,418 children were taken into custody at the border. Unaccompanied minors peaked in 2014, with 68,000 apprehensions. Analysts say 2021 is

on pace to break that record, with more than 600 children currently arriving daily at the U.S.-Mexico border. Click [here](#) for a flyer with more information.
