#### **PHILOSOPHY**

Children in kindergarten through sixth grade benefit from an after school setting that fosters self-esteem and reinforces social and academic skills. Almost Home/Club J is a warm, safe, stimulating, professionally supervised environment dedicated to providing age appropriate activities in an enriched educational, recreational and social setting.

Indeed, the Almost Home staff has a strong track record of working with parents and teachers to identify the needs of children to maximize their experiences in Almost Home. In the event of family difficulties, illness or unusual circumstances, please advise the Directors. This information will only be shared with staff as-needed to help meet your child's changing needs.

Almost Home staff may contact you to discuss observations or changes in a child's behavior or difficulties during the course of the day. Your input is very important to us. Please feel free to call to discuss your child's needs at any time.

#### **STAFF**

Our outstanding staff includes teachers from the JCC summer camps as well as students training for positions in education, community service, and other related fields. All child care staff and volunteers undergo an interview, reference check and screening through the Office of Child and Family Services. Staff members participate in ongoing supervision and training.

# **CLUB J ACTIVITIES**

Prior to and following their extracurricular program, students in Club J will participate in a variety of activities which vary from day to day, including homework assistance, arts and crafts, board games, playground time, sports, and other outdoor activities. Please dress children appropriately, from snow boots to sun hats.

The JCC is not responsible for misplaced belongings. Please label all jackets, hats, scarves, water bottles, etc.

Please do not send toys or electronics (i.e. dolls, action figures, gun-type toys, computer programs, cell phones, iPad's or other expensive items). Any and all weapon-type toys are expressly prohibited.

#### **HOMEWORK**

Students will begin homework shortly after they arrive at program. Our staff will provide a quiet work-space for the students during this time. Students will have ample time to complete as much homework as they can before we begin our outdoor and/or other planned activities. If students have not finished their homework by that time, they will have additional time to resume their work later in the afternoon.

#### **SNACK**

Daily snack is included in your Club J tuition. Snacks will include items such as pretzels and crackers, etc. Snacks will be nut-free and kosher-style. If your child has food allergies, you must note this on their registration forms.

# **HOURS OF OPERATION**

Club J enrollment runs on a semester-long basis, in alignment with the JCC's schedule of extracurricular activities.

When your child's extra-curricular activity comes to conclusion (in fall, winter or spring), so too will your enrolment in Club J conclude. At that time, parents must update their children's transportation arrangements from school.

Club J provides childcare Mondays through Thursdays, from school dismissal until 6:00 p.m.

Club J does not run when schools are closed.

Club J will accommodate routinely scheduled early-dismissal days. Specifically, every other Wednesday, students in the Irvington schools are dismissed one hour earlier than usual. Club J will also include childcare on occasionally scheduled-half days.

If an extracurricular is cancelled, Club J is still available. Club J runs through the entirety of the semester; even if the extracurricular is cancelled for a reason outside of our control, Club J will run for the full afternoon.

Club J follows the Tarrytown and Irvington school calendars. The following calendar lists currently known school and JCC closings that affect Club J; as schools sometimes adjust their schedules for conference days, etc., we will update this calendar accordingly. Reminders will be posted and e-mailed.

When one school is closed but the other school is open, Almost Home is OPEN. You can bring your child here at 11:00 am.

#### **SNOW DAYS**

When the Irvington and Tarrytown schools dismiss early or are closed, there will be no Almost Home/Club J. If either district remains open <u>until normal dismissal time</u>, Almost Home/Club J will run as usual. However, if driving conditions become difficult as the day progresses, we will communicate to parents to pick their children up as early as possible. Almost Home/Club J is unaffected by delayed openings of the public schools. Almost Home/Club J and JCC closings will be posted on our website, <u>shamesicc.org</u>.

# **EARLY DISMISSAL/HALF DAYS**

# **Early Dismissal:**

As noted on the calendar, when the Irvington and/or Tarrytown schools schedule early dismissals, the JCC will operate Almost Home/Club J to accommodate them. We will welcome students from their early or half-day school dismissal time through 6:00 pm. This coverage is included in each student's fee.

Students must bring their own kosher-style, dairy/ pareve, and nut-free bag lunch on these days. As previously stated, Almost Home/Club J does not run on days when schools close early due to inclement weather.

# **HEALTH REGULATIONS**

A medical form, signed by a physician, with a record of immunizations and current physical examination, must be returned ASAP. No child will be accepted without a current physical and complete medical form on file. If your child's medical expires during the school year, we will need a new one as soon as possible If you do not have a current medical form, you must provide a doctor's note confirming that a physical exam is scheduled in the near term and that you will promptly provide the completed form following the visit.

If your child requires medication during Almost Home hours, the medication must be in its original container. Cold or other temporary medications are subject to the same regulations and forms as medications prescribed for ongoing treatments. All medications stored at the JCC are kept in a lock box. A completed medication form including parent and physician signatures is required to administer medication. Please consult your child's physician and/or Almost Home@shamesicc.org for the required medication consent form.

As a general rule, children too sick to attend school are too sick to attend Almost Home/Club J. Please notify us if your child has been diagnosed with a highly contagious condition (For example: flu, Covid-19, head lice, chicken pox, strep throat, pink eye) so that we may alert other parents to look out for symptoms. If a student in AH is diagnosed with a contagious condition, families will be notified by email. Names will not be mentioned in our communication.

Staff members must follow the same sick policies.

Subject to and consistent with applicable law, The AH Leadership Team reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to at any time exclude children and/or staff from the program based on legitimate concern about risk to communal health and welfare.

# **NOTIFICATION OF ABSENCES**

If your child will not be attending Almost Home/Club J on a regularly scheduled day or will be taking a later bus, you must notify the Almost Home leadership team by email to <a href="mailto:almosthome@shamesjcc.org">almosthome@shamesjcc.org</a> or phone call to 914-366-7898 ext. 1168. Notification to the JCC's Welcome Desk staff or others is insufficient for this purpose.

If after school activities will delay your child's arrival on a recurring basis (sports, band, orchestra, etc), one notice of the new arrival time, with starting and ending dates, is sufficient.

Attendance is taken each day when school buses arrive. If an expected child is not on the bus, the Almost Home staff will attempt to call parents at home, at work, and on cell phones. The schools will not call us when your child is absent or dismissed early. Failure to inform us of absences may result in additional fees and/or suspension from our program.

There is no discount or refund for missed AH/Club J days. AH/Club J offers childcare according to school schedules and as noted in the calendar above.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Tarrytown and Irvington schools provide free bus transportation to the JCC. While we are in constant contact with the schools and transportation offices, parents are responsible for confirming their child's bus space and notifying the school that their child will be attending the JCC after school program.

# **PICK UP**

#### Location

All students enrolled in AH/Club J will be picked up at the JCC's Legacy Building (with the blue awning) OR starting week 2, there will be two alternative pickup locations. (See details below).

#### **Authorization**

Your online registration included options for identification of any/all adults who are authorized to pick-up your child. If you must adjust such "authorized pick-ups" please communicate revisions in writing by email to the Almost Home leadership team <a href="mailto:almosthome@shamesjcc.org">almosthome@shamesjcc.org</a>.

- If someone is picking up who does not usually pick up, but they are on your form, please notify us so that we know to look for them.
- If someone is picking up who was <u>not</u> identified during registration, we will need a permission note from the child's parents or guardian (handwritten note with signature or email <u>almosthome@shamesjcc.org</u>).

We will not release your child to anyone who is not listed on the registration without verifying that there is a note from a parent/guardian. Do not rely on the school to pass notes on to us. Every child must be signed out by a designated caregiver.

## **Pick-up Process**

Upon arrival at the JCC, parents and caregivers must park their vehicles in a proper parking spot and enter the Legacy Building. Upon arrival, parents and caregivers will buzz in and approach the front desk staff to share their name and the name(s) of the child(ren) they are picking up.

Then, Welcome Desk staff will radio to Almost Home staff who will escort your child to the lobby.

Beginning week 2, parents will have the option of picking up their child from two alternate locations: the field and the gymnasium in the main building. An adult will have a tablet to sign out your child. You MUST park in one of the lots to pick your child up from the field or the main building. PARKING ALONG ANY CURB IS PROHIBITED.

# Pick-up Timing

If you or an alternate, authorized person will not be able to pick up by 6:00 pm, the JCC should be notified. The JCC will try to accommodate unexpected delays, but we appreciate your efforts to be on time or send word.

If we have not heard from the regular pick-up person by 6:15 p.m., the Almost Home staff will attempt to reach the relevant parents and then, someone on the child's emergency contact list. Once a listed adult arrives for the child, we will leave a message on the parent's "Best Phone Number to Call" voice-mail identifying who we released the child to.

In the event repeated late pick-ups, the JCC will charge additional fees and/or suspend program participation.

# **REGISTRATION FEES**

#### All PAYMENTS WILL BE DRAFTED IN OUR ONLINE SYSTEM.

The JCC keeps your credit/debit card or bank draft information in our billing system. The JCC's billing program charges you for Club J at the time of enrollment; payment in-full is due at that time.

Club J fees are based on a session schedule. Fees account for holidays and other school closings, and do not include JCC membership fees.

#### **FINANCIAL AID**

The Shames JCC on the Hudson is deeply committed to enabling access to its child-care programs to families in many different financial circumstances. Need-based scholarship assistance is available for qualifying families. #### **REFUND POLICIES**

As of 3 weeks prior to the start of the Club J session, through conclusion of the program, fees paid are non-refundable.

Families may withdraw enrollment by written communication to the JCC (email to almosthome@shamesjcc.org).

No reduction in fees will be given for absences.

If a child is asked to leave the program for any reason, a pro-rated refund will be issued.
